2.3 Call for sites: The general announcement to all residents has been made on social media, notice boards and the council website. #### 3. Community engagement

- 3.1 **Next public meeting**: A provisional date for the next public meeting in the village hall is 8<sup>th</sup> May, 7 to 9 pm. The precise date will be set once adequate drafts of the Neighbourhood Plan, Design Guidelines and Housing Needs Assessment have been delivered by the consultants. The proposed agenda is:
  - Introduction to explain the neighbourhood planning procedure and where we are in this
    process.
  - Present the various maps produced, their key themes and intensions behind them.
  - Discuss the 'call for sites' and the criteria for filtering the proposals from landowners. Note: Chris will draft the criteria for discussion by the group.

#### 4. Next Steps for neighbourhood plan

- 4.1 **Maps**: A special group meeting to focus on maps was held on the 3<sup>rd</sup> April at the village hall. The approach taken to defining the future development boundaries (up to 2040) was to highlight the current development boundaries, propose protected 'green wedges' between the settlements and hence, by implication, land between the two are designated 'grey' areas for potential development subject to the usual planning process.
- 4.2 **Land ownership**: Letters and emails to be sent to all landowners early next week covering the 'call for sites' and the proposed date for the next public meeting. Chris to action in coordination with Rob and Tim.

4.3 **Solar farms**: The land to the south of the parish was included in a recent map published by 'Friends of the Earth' showing areas ideally suited to host solar farms. Therefore, it is suggested to include a policy on this specific topic, or on renewable energy in general, in the neighbourhood plan. Chris will seek Helen's views on how other parishes have approached this subject and review the Central Lincolnshire plan for any issues arising.
