Action Item Description 1. Actions from last meeting 11.6 Steve has produced a draft plan showing the major tasks required to complete the SR / CM 11.6 Neighbourhood Plan. On hold. Until funding for 2024/5 is agreed. 15.7 Chris to review the Central Lincolnshire Local Plan for any relevant information on CM 15.7 renewable energy policies. Ongoing. 17.1,17.3 Two or more members of the steering group will meet with landowners who & 20.3 responded to the 'call for sites' to clarify the details and provide more information on CM / All 17.1 the types and character of the developments proposed. **Ongoing**. See 3.1. 18.0 Applications for government funding for 2024/5 is now open. Janet & Chris to CM / JB 18.0 progress. Ongoing. See 2.1. 19.2 Helen Metcalf is requesting all the maps we wish to include in the Neighbourhood CM 19.2 Plan document. Chris to arrange. Ongoing. See 2.2. 19.4 Chris will arrange for AECOM to provide an independent assessment of the sites proposed from the 'call for sites' exercise conducted in April / May. Ongoing. This CM 19.4 request forms part of the application for funding in 2024/5. See 2.1. CM 20.1 20.1 Concern was expressed that the cost and timescales for consultancy help on the Neighbourhood Plan were currently unclear. Ongoing. See 2.2. 20.2 Chris to make the map modifications agreed at the group meeting of 11th July. CM 20.2 Ongoing.

## 2. Progress since last meeting

- 2.1 Grant application & technical help: We now have confirmation of the costs and grant amounts available to complete the Neighbourhood Plan and an independent assessment of the proposed 'call for sites'. Chris and Janet will meet this Friday (26<sup>th</sup> July) to finalise and submit the online grant application. Note: it can take up to 4 weeks for Locality to process the claim, however it is understood recent submissions have been settled well within this timeframe.
- 2.2 **Neighbourhood Plan status**: Chris held a call with Helen Metcalf on the 23<sup>rd</sup> July to discuss progress. The following are the main points arising:
  - Cost for the remaining consultancy and grant amounts were agreed.
  - Helen has drafted policies for 5 sections in the plan but requires all the updated maps to complete her work prior to releasing a draft for steering group review. Chris will send the remaining updated maps to her tomorrow.
  - Subject to a successful grant application, Helen now expects to provide a full draft of the Neighbourhood Plan to the steering group by September.
