Rob has compiled a map of green spaces in Grasby and will provide photos to Chris. **RB 22.6** 21.2 An indicative layout of the proposed development for the field between Clixby and CM 21.2 Bentley Lanes. Chris has produced an indicative map for discussion. Ongoing. 21.4 Mark has contacted Hannah Dale who is happy to contribute to the flora and fauna section of the plan. Ongoing. Information received, Mark to share with the group. MP 21.4 21.5 The current steering group consultation statement on the parish council website requires an update. Chris will progress. Ongoing. CM 21.5 21.8 An email is to be sent to all landowners who submitted a 'call for sites' proposal to update them on progress and inform them of the forthcoming AECOM Site Assessment. Note: Chris has spoken to the Bushby's directly. Ongoing. CM21.8 23.4 Rob noted that there are many redundant farm buildings in the parishes which provide the potential for conversion to residential properties (e.g. Class Q developments). List provided by Rob. Closed. The Nation Planning Policy Framework is currently under review and consultation. Tom forwarded a copy of the revised policy which has been sent out to the group. Note: finalisation of the policy is not expected until early 2025. Closed. 24.2 All steering group members were asked to provide any additional comments on the draft Neighbourhood Plan to Chris prior to the meeting with Helen. Closed.

2. Progress since last meeting

- 2.1 Neighbourhood Plan updates: Steve is to forward a suggested revision for the introductory paragraph to the group. The following additional aspirations for the parishes were discussed:
 - Providing allotments
 - Improving healthcare provision, e.g. arranging regular mobile doctor visits.
 - Keeping the School and Cross Keys open.
 - Improving the local economy. Steve will provide a strawman on this topic to the group.

Chris has also provided criteria to support the ordering of the local green spaces.

3. Community engagement

3.1 **Meetings with landowners**: All meetings will be concluded prior to the next meeting. AECOM are to visit the sites as part of their assessment but do not need to meet with the landowners directly. We await the date of their proposed visit in order that the group can support them on the day. A simple traffic lights system will be used by AECOM to indicate the suitability of each site for development. Once the assessment is completed the steering group will prioritise the sites in terms of housing density and development timescales. Helen recommends residents are then consulted regarding the proposed development schedule. The format of the public consultation will be reviewed at the next meeting.

- 4.3 Request Helen provided examples on economic development statements for the plan.
