3. <u>Community engagement</u>

- 3.1 Regulation 14 requires a mandatory 6 week consultation period with all residents of the parishes regarding the final pre-submission draft version of the Neighbourhood Plan. Once available, we need to publicise the draft plan and illicit comments from the community. The mechanism for this consultation needs to be agreed by the group at the next meeting.
- 3.2 The public meeting to consult with the community on the site allocations process and decisions will be held on 23rd April 2025 between 6pm and 8pm at the Village Hall. Chris will prepare an update for presentation and Julie will liaise with Janet on providing refreshments on the night. The event has already been publicised on social media and the JT 36.5 parish council website. Flyers are also to be placed on the local notice boards.
- 3.3 Chris and Steve met with the landowners of the playground site in Searby. The following are the main matters arising from the discussion:
 - It is now considered the land should be made available for all community amenities, not just a playground.
 - A potential solution to the acquisition of the land for the prescribed purpose would be to agree a long-term lease, say 99 or 999 years, from the landowner to Grasby Parish Council. Mark will discuss with Tim (as a solicitor and chair of the Searby cum Owmby parish meeting) on progressing this approach. Steve will also independently seek advice on this matter.
 - The landowner has recently enquired on allocating this land as a 'green space'. Chris will seek to understand the repercussions on the provision of community amenities should this be perused.
 - The landowner is keen to make progress on safeguarding this land as quickly as possible. Hence, the group should maintain a regular dialogue with them over the coming months.

Matters arising: It was felt that merging the Grasby and Searby cum Owmby parishes under the administration of a single Parish Council may be beneficial, not only in progressing the acquisition of this land, but in the general progression of the community aspirations in the future. Mark to discuss with Tim and Steve to contact Peter on the feasibly and desirability of such a merger.

The steering group activity summary on the parish council website requires an update. CM / SR 36.9 Chris and Steve to progress.

4. Next steps for neighbourhood plan

- 4.1 The following steps are proposed:
 - Issue a full, pre-submission draft of the plan to the steering group and Nev Brown (by 18th April).
 - Complete the SEA Screening report and submit to Nev Brown with the Neighbourhood Plan (as above).
 - Send the grant report to Locality (by 14th April).
 - Prepare for the public meeting on the 23rd April (publicise on the local notice boards).

5. Actions arising and next meeting

Chris has a picture from the early 1900s of a large village gathering at the bottom of Front Street. We could consider recreating such a gathering as a social event for the community. Steve to approach Mike on his thoughts.


