2. <u>Progress since last meeting</u>

- 2.1 **Neighbourhood Plan update**: The Neighbourhood Plan and the SEA/HRA Screening Opinion are now with WLDC to progress. Nev Brown (Senior Neighbourhood Planning Policy Officer) acknowledged receipt of the documents and it is expected that a determination on SEA/HRA will be made on, or by, the 6th October.
- 2.2 Chris will send Steve the Neighbourhood Plan changes log and an updated steering group CM 45.1 activity summary for posting on the Parish Council website.
- 2.3 Chris will clarify the position with Nev regarding canvassing in the community by members of the steering group prior to the referendum on the Neighbourhood Plan.

2.4 **Finances**: Cllr. Peter Morris has indicated that funding to cover our current shortfall of £2,500 and to complete the Neighbourhood Plan may be available from the WLDC Community Fund. Peter will contact the group once confirmed and applications for funding is open. It is envisaged a small amount of additional funds will be needed to cover a final

leaflet drop to all residents and to hold one more public meeting prior the plan referendum.
